Rainforest Memory Game

For two or more players

TWO times so that you have a double set.
You could even ask your parent to take
them to the stationery store to have them inexpensively laminated.
Now cut out each card very carefully – they must all look exactly the same from the back side of the card.

How to Play your Rainforest Memory Game

- Mix up all the cards and place them all face down on the table.
- Players take it in turns to turn over 2 cards. Everyone can look at the pictures and try to remember where they are on the table. Turn the 2 cards face down again.
- The next person now turns over 2 cards.
- When a player turns over a picture the same as one you have seen he/she should try to remember where the first picture is – and pick it up to make a pair.
- The player who collects the most pairs wins.
